The Role: This role will involve preparing a meal for 12 people – 10 clients and 2 staff members. Whether you would like to cook once a week, every other week or monthly – it's entirely up to you! The role consists of buying the ingredients with a budget determined by LeatherHead Start and cooking a meal of your choice to be ready by 6pm.

Role description:

- » Prepare a nutritious meal for 12 people using the LeatherHead Start fully equipped kitchen
- » Choose a suitable day for you that fills a space in the meals rota
- » Purchase the needed ingredients and stick within a budget of £25
- » Consult staff when deciding what meal to cook
- » As far as is possible to make sure the meal is ready by 6pm

- » Good time keeping
- » Good communication skills
